

Clever K9s Class Information:



- Check in up at the front counter before each class.
- Bring your dog hungry (do not feed dinner), full dogs are less willing to work for treats and can be more distracted by other dogs and people in the class. Full dogs also have a higher chance of having an accident during class.
- Potty your dog before class, please use the area between the parking lot and the sidewalk. Bags and a trash receptacle are provided for your convenience. Please do not potty your dog in the bushes by the building. If your dog may have to potty during class, you may excuse yourself quietly at any time.
- Lightly exercise your dog before class to take some of the edge off but not so much that your dog is too tired to participate.
- Bring lots of bite size, smelly, yummy, chewy treats, in multiple flavors. (NO crunchy treats unless there is a medical reason.) *We do not allow any treats heavy in red dye. They cause permanent damage to our floors.*
- Bring a treat bag that hooks onto your waist/belt (Can be purchased at Clever K9s) or clothing that has an easily accessible pocket.
- Bring your dog on any one of the following training aids during class...Flat buckle or quick release collar, martingale, body harness, anti-pull harness, or head harness. Dogs must be on a straight fabric 4' or 6' leash.

We do not allow choke chains, prong or static collars. Chain and retractable leashes are also not permitted. If you have a concern, please let your instructor know.

- Yellow Bandana Club! If you see a dog in class wearing a yellow bandanna, please give this dog space. It may be shy, not like other humans/dogs, fearful, in training for a special purpose. If you feel your dog may need a yellow bandanna, please let your instructor know.
- Last but not least.....Bring a great attitude and a sense of humor!
